



TEXAS HOLDEM POKER

Rules:

Small Blind – 2 CHIPS

Big Blind – 4 CHIPS

-Each player dealt two private cards facing down

-Pre-flop Betting Round—each player makes a bet. Players can call, raise, or fold

Call – match the previous players bet to keep playing

Raise – Raise the bet that players have to match to stay in the hand

Fold – Forfeit that hands bet and don't win any chips

-Dealer burns a card then flips three cards face up called the flop—communal cards anyone can use in combination with their own cards to form a poker hand

-Player to the left of the dealer starts another betting round

-Dealer burns a card then flips one more called the turn

-Another round of betting

-Dealer Burns a card and flips final card for the hand

-Final round of betting

-All players who have not folded reveal their cards; Best hand wins

Poker Hands (Best to Worst)

Royal Flush: Ace – Ten Same Suit

Straight Flush: Five cards in a row of the same suit

Four of a Kind: ex 4 Aces, 4 Queens, 4 Nines, etc

Full House: 3 of one rank + 2 of another; ie: 3 Kings + 2 Queens (Kings full of Queens)

Flush: Any 5 cards of the same suit; highest card determines the rank of the flush (Ace= highest)

Straight: Any consecutive 5 cards, not matter the suit. Aces can count high or low

Three of a Kind: 3 cards of the same rank;

Two Pair: 2 Cards of the same rank + other 2 cards of the same rank; Higher of two pairs determines rank

One Pair: Any two cards of the same rank
